The giant Panda is our school mascot. Pandas are interesting animals.

A panda's digestive system is similar to a deer's digestive system. Giant pandas like bamboo for food and grass. They eat fish and small animals as a side dish. They only digest a fifth of what they eat.

Giant pandas live in the heavily forested range of China's mountains. There are about 1,590 giant pandas in the wild. The oldest panda lives in Japan. Pandas have a better chance of surviving in captivity than the wild. However there are only about 127 in captivity.

The average weight of a baby giant panda is about 360 grams. The average adult panda weight is 300 lbs. Their height is 6ft. The force of their jaws is 28 lbs. of pressure.











