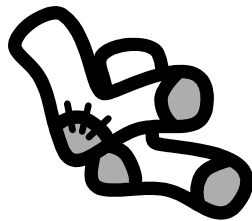

A: I want to be a good wife and mother.

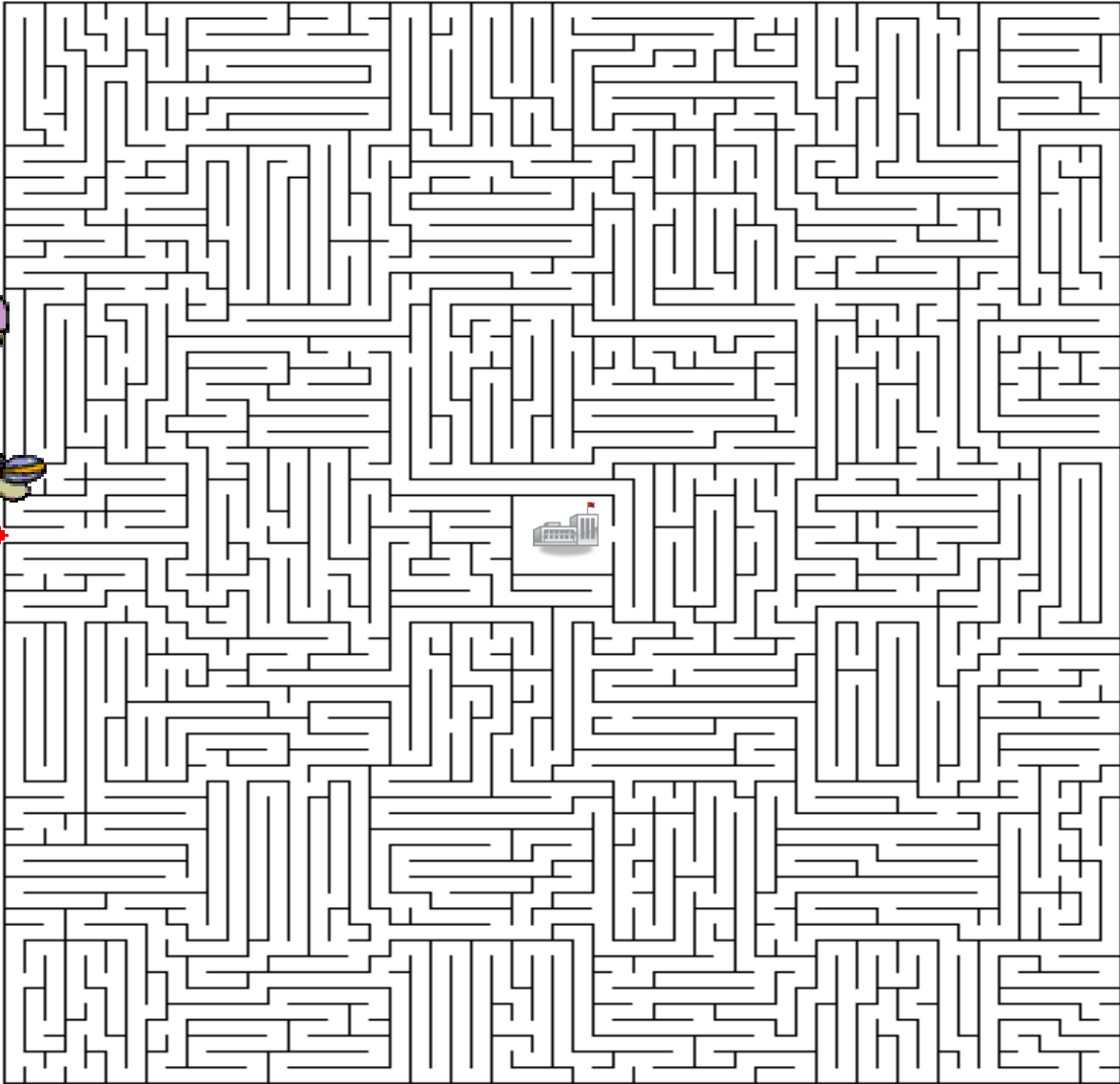
